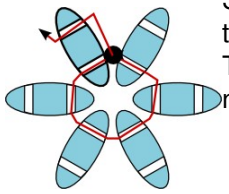


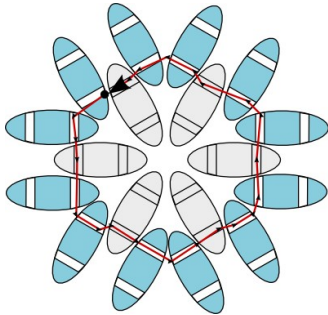
Superduo Snowflakes

1)



String 6 Superduo beads, move them to the end of the thread and tie a knot to form a circle. Then make a step-up - go to the second hole of the nearest Superduo

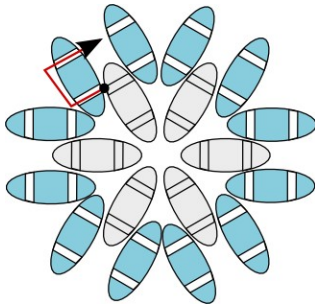
2)



Add two Superduos and then go through the second hole of next Superduo from the first row.

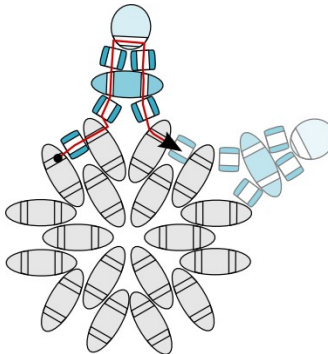
Repeat until you reach the end of the row.

Now make the step-up

4)



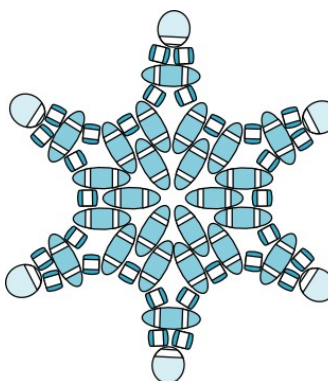
Add one 11/0 bead and then go to the second hole of next Superduo in the previous row.

Add one 11/0, one Superduo, one 11/0, one drop and one 11/0. Then go down through the second hole of the new Superduo.

Add one more 11/0 bead and then go through the second hole of next Superduo in the second row.

Keep very firm tension.




5)



Repeat step 4 until you reach the end. Tie a few half-hitch knots and cut off the thread.

To make earrings, open a jump ring, put it through one of the 5/0 beads and close it. Then attach ear wires. You can also use these as pendants, Christmas ornaments or home decorations.

Material and supplies:

-  Superduo beads (one or two colors)
-  11/0 Japanese seed beads
-  5/0 seed beads or magatamas
- Beading needle
- Thread (Nymo, Fireline)

Optional:

- Jump rings (big enough to fit inside 5/0 seed beads)
- Ear wires

Difficulty: for beginners
